



Onsite Color Blending

Color variations are not considered grading defects within MFMA Grading Rules. Bundles of maple flooring are generally mixed on site to enhance color blending of maple flooring strips to avoid groups of darker boards from being placed in the same area.

Even with proper blending, it is impossible to identify those maple flooring strips that will have a darker appearance once floor sealer is applied. Color variations of this type are expected and considered normal. A complete list of grading characteristics and restrictions appear in the MFMA Grading Rules publication.
